During semester testing days, 9-11 students who meet the criteria may be released from their semester testing periods with a parental note. Grades 9-11 students may also be released from study halls with parental permission during semester testing days. Students who are released must leave the school building and grounds unless they are under direct supervision of school personnel.

The second semester testing schedule is printed in this newsletter. Note that the semester testing schedule will end at 1:30 on both days. All students will be released both days at 1:30 p.m. School lunch will be served on the semester testing days.

The Class of 2010 is counting down the days until graduation. Graduation has been set for 7:00 p.m. on Friday, May 14. The class is commended for their academic and activity achievements and wished a bright future as they continue to pursue their goals.
