Grades 9-11 students may also be released from study halls with parental permission, during semester testing days. 7-12 students will be released at 1:00 p.m. on semester testing days.

On Friday, May 10, the graduation ceremony for the class of 2013 will begin at 7:00 p.m. Members of the class are commended for their academic and activity achievements and wished a bright future as they begin their life outside of Ponca School.

STUDENTS MUST BE OUT OF THE SCHOOL BUILDING AND OFF SCHOOL GROUNDS DURING THE TIMES THEY ARE NOT WRITING TESTS, UNLESS THEY ARE UNDER DIRECT SUPERVISION OF SCHOOL PERSONNEL.

or have a new baby in your household?**

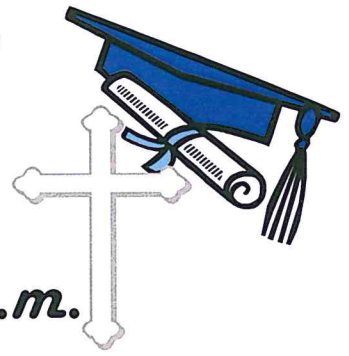
The school district is required to conduct an annual census every June for children age 0-21. These census numbers are used by the Nebr. Department of Education for State Aid and for federal funding.




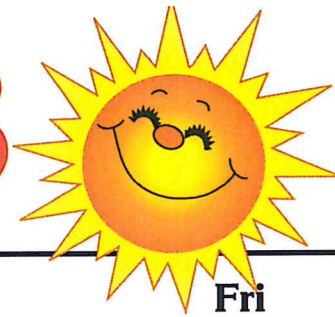
