

**Minutes of the Ponca Public Schools
Special Board of Education Meeting
March 30, 2020**

The Board of Education of Dixon County School District 1 (also known as Ponca Public Schools) held a special meeting on Monday, March 30, 2020 in the Ponca Public Schools library at 505 3rd Street, Ponca, Nebraska. The meeting was convened in open and public session and advance notice was publicly posted at the Bank of Dixon County, the post office and the school house door, and given to all members of the Board of Education. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the publicized notice and a current copy of the agenda was kept continuously current and available for inspection at the office of the Superintendent of Schools. All proceedings of the Board of Education, except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. The open session of the meeting was available to the public via videoconference due to the CDC's limitation of public gatherings to 10 people or less.

President Book called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., informed the public that a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall of the meeting room, and led the salute to the flag. Roll call was taken and the following members were present: Kenton Book, Monte Burki, Richard Dohma, Shawn Fethkenher, John Gill and Phil Kramper. Also present were interim superintendent candidate Mr. Duane Krusemark and board secretary Lorrie Huston.

Mr. Krusemark was interviewed by the Board members for the position of interim superintendent.

With a motion by Burki, second by Fethkenher, the Board entered into executive session at 6:24 pm for personnel and the evaluation of job performance clearly necessary for the protection of the public interest or for the prevention of needless injury to the reputation of an individual in compliance with the law. Voting Aye: Book, Burki, Dohma, Fethkenher, Gill, and Kramper. M.C.U.

At 6:45 pm, Kramper moved to end the executive session and resume open session. Gill seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Book, Burki, Dohma, Fethkenher, Gill, and Kramper. M.C.U.

Kramper made a motion to approve the interim superintendent contract offer to Duane Krusemark under the parameters discussed. Dohma seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Book, Burki, Dohma, Fethkenher, Gill, and Kramper. M.C.U.

The next regular meeting will be held on Monday, April 20, 2020 at 7:30 p.m.

At 6:47 pm, there being no further business, Burki moved to adjourn the meeting. Gill seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Book, Burki, Dohma, Fethkenher, Gill, and Kramper. M.C.U.
