

Mr. Terupt Projects

Please choose one of the following options for your Because of Mr. Terupt Project. All projects will be due 1 week after the completion of the book.

OPTION 1: Book Trailer using GoogleSlides or Power Point

This option is for students who want practice with technology and enjoyed the ancient civilization slide project. You are familiar with movie trailers you see during previews, but have you seen a book trailer? It is designed to hook the audience into reading the novel. Often times they give *too much* information about the book itself, but in this case that's okay.

- An opening slide that include the title, the author, and it's targeted audience
- One slide per character with an image of how *you* imagine this character to be
- One character trait per character listed and the role they have in the novel & at least 3 total quotes as evidence to show "who the character is"
- A slide that demonstrates the importance of the different character traits and how the class comes together
- Provide enough information to get the viewer hooked but do not give away the ending!

OPTION 2: You are Mr. Terupt!

Calling all creative writers! In this option, you are to write a chapter from the perspective of the teacher, Mr. Terupt. You can decide which month Mr. Terupt is writing during and who he is writing to.

- Writing should be written in first person, as told by Mr. Terupt
- Writing should have the Month as the heading and whom he is talking about should be the subheading (use fun fonts like the novel!)
- Create one subheading of your choice, which could be about another person mentioned in the novel, his overall experience, or his response to an event!
- Follow the structure of the novel, Mr. Terupt should include at least 1 paragraph about each student in his class

*Mr. Terupt must give a character trait for each student in his class

OPTION 3: Dollar Word Poster/Slide

Make a dollar word poster or slide based on the method presented in the book.

- You must find at least 25 words minimum to be eligible for a “76%/C”, 35 words minimum to be eligible for “85% /B, 50 words to be eligible for a “93% / A”.
- All words must include the equation you used to prove your word is worth a dollar.

example : excellent = 5 + 24+ 3+5+12+12+15+14+20= \$100

- Final copy must be creative and colorful! Your grade is also based upon creativity of how you present your words, as well as neatness.
